THOUGHT FOR THE MONTH

April 12th is Easter Sunday and for many there will be Easter egg hunts and chocolate for breakfast instead of the usual toast or cereal or whatever. Eggs given as a sign of a new beginning, a new birth, possibly the start of Spring. However, for Christians throughout the world, Easter is the most important date in the year. It is the highlight of our faith bringing all God's promises to us to its climax.

We will have been building up to this event through the weeks of Lent which began on Ash Wednesday after all the pancakes had been eaten. It is a time when the days start *lengthening* out and a time for reflection on our Christian life.

Then as we approach the week before Easter, we relive the last week of Jesus' life on earth with all its very highs and very lows. Jesus had been preaching, teaching and healing for three years before he joins his family, friends and many other pilgrims journeying into Jerusalem where the crowds hailed him as a king and laid palms and their cloaks on the road for his donkey to walk on, (Palm Sunday, a high point).

The pilgrims were gathering for the annual festival of the Passover and the great sharing, Seder meal which we remember on Maundy Thursday and which provides the basis for all our communion services. After the meal, Jesus went and prayed and then allowed himself to be taken prisoner by the Roman authorities who together with the leaders of the Jews in Jerusalem thought his popularity could be a danger. Jesus was tortured and beaten and the following day, crucified, a very cruel death. Jesus was an innocent man who gave his life in place of all the wrong things that we say or do, that God may smile on us, (Good Friday, a very low point).

But Jesus defeated death and rose from the dead on Easter Sunday (the highest of high points), and Christians everywhere celebrate this day with great joy. Jesus appeared to his friends several times over the following weeks before he left this earth for good but that is a story for another month.

I wish you every blessing this Easter and for the remainder of the year and I hope that your faith will carry you through all the traumas hitting us at the moment with the corona virus, concerns on the state of our climate and many other issues.
