INKBERROW MARKS VE DAY

The end of World War II is called 'Victory for Europe' day; VE Day 8th May (the war in the Far East continuing for a few months longer) . The end of the War prompted wild rejoicing in London and now, 75 years later, it has been marked by very restrained celebrations on account of the Covid19 pandemic. Our local community was not to be deprived of a modest celebration and so a few public-spirited individuals notified their neighbours of plans for a 'socially distanced' gathering where we would decorate our frontages in red, white and blue and bring our picnic tables and chairs up to the roadside to enjoy drinks and snacks. The picture shows the residents of Dingle End enjoying their refreshments and having a chance to chat to their neighbours in the lovely spring sunshine.

THE WOMEN'S INSTITUTE CELEBRATES ITS CENTENARY

Those who have driven in and out of Inkberrow over the past few months cannot fail to have noticed handsome planters under the Inkberrow name signs, filled with flowering plants and bearing the notice 'Inkberrow WI Centenary 1920-2020'.

In addition, the W.I. was provided with 100 bare-rooted trees for planting in a publicly accessible site. The problem was finding a suitable location but a few old-timers knew of 'Inkberrow Common', an area of over 1 acre at the Junction of Priory Farm Road and Knighton Lane. The site was in poor condition due to it having become infested with brambles and strewn with brick rubble. However, a large digger was engaged to remove the brambles and then pass over the site again to remove larger boulders and tree roots. The bare-rooted trees arrived complete with tree guards and supporting stakes, all of them native British species, and planting proceeded in the autumn with many volunteers and their spouses turning up to dig holes, add compost and plant a tree. Autumn and early spring were very wet but from late spring onwards the weather turned warm, dry and very sunny. It also coincided with the incidence of Covid19 and 'social distancing'. As a stream passes along one boundary of the site, access to water was not a problem but water had to be transported uphill from the stream to the trees. A redundant cattle trough was loaned by a local farmer and then others lent a pump and a motor to lift the water from the stream to the trough. One W.I. member had the brilliant idea of installing a notice, 'Adopt a tree for free', the condition being that this adopted tree had to be kept watered during the dry spring and weeded around its base. This scheme worked wonderfully well with 'social distancing' as the spacing between the trees is 3 metres so, villagers of all ages were able to take their outdoor exercise and then, having brought their water containers could fill them from the trough and keep their tree watered without flouting the social distancing rules. Trees have been adopted by young and old, some have selected only one tree, others an entire row, their adopted tree marked with their name written on the tree stake. To date most trees have been adopted so hurry along if you would like one; only a few remaining! Most of the volunteers have also been working on the brick rubble either by making circles around their tree, or by moving bricks into cairns by the lane to be taken away by another helpful farmer. Not all the trees have survived the extremes of weather but many are leafing up and in 2-3 years time the plantation should look like a new wood of all native British species and an area to be enjoyed by one and all.

PARENTS AND GOVERNORS RECOGNISE STAFF AT INKBERROW PRIMARY SCHOOL

The parents and governors at Inkberrow Primary School have expressed their gratitude to staff for the extra-ordinary way in which they have responded to the current health crisis. All staff will be receiving a hamper of food to share with their families. Chair of Governors, Noel Fowler, said “We wanted to acknowledge and reward all staff for their commitment to the children and willingness to adapt to the developing situation”

He added “I am also upset about the way in which the media and some politicians have treated those working in school in stark contrast to those in the health and social care services. The fact is that schools have not closed, ours has been open every day for key-worker children, including during Easter and half term breaks. In addition staff have been providing detailed support to parents working with their children at home.”

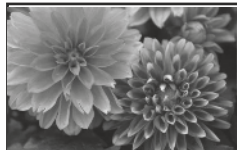
Karen Uppal, chair of the Friends of Inkberrow Primary School and a parent at the school said, “Lots of us have appreciated the effort the teachers have made to support parents and their children during this challenging time and were pleased to contribute to this thank you gift for all the staff.”

Glenn Duggan, head teacher said “We are so pleased that the Parents and Governors have acknowledged the staff for their ongoing dedication to the children's learning since the closures were announced. Over the past ten weeks, all teachers and staff have gone above and beyond to ensure our children at Inkberrow have continued to have access to their teacher and to their learning. I am very proud of all of them.”

Each member of staff received a hamper provided by The Bull's Head pub in the village containing fruit scones, strawberry jam and cream, as well as savoury items such as scotch egg and sausage roll.

The project was arranged through the Friends of Inkberrow Primary School and included donations from individual governors.

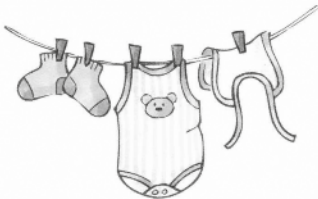

How about joining in a project, in this
“Lockdown Season”?

You may like to do this individually or as
part of a family team.

Let us see who can grow some tall and cheerful sunflower plants
and flowers. Further details of how to take part and a “Record
Sheet” are available on request. (See below for details).

Initially, plant seeds in pot of compost, or seed tray. Later
plant the small sunflower plants directly in the soil of your
garden or in a large pot or tub. (They are likely to be a special
commercial seed prepared for the purpose, rather than the
type you get in your breakfast cereal or bread!) Various
varieties of sunflower seed are on sale. Some varieties achieve
height and size; others form clusters or display different
shades of colour, Take your choice and best wishes for a vivid
display in the autumn.

In taking part, you will in effect be engaging in a STEM - type
project, over a period of several months.

Inkberrow Parish Council

The latest Parish Council meeting was held on 17th June 2020 via web cam.

A member of the public reminded Members that on 6th February 2022 Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II will have been our Queen for 70 years and expressed a desire for Inkberrow to start planning appropriate celebrations.

The problems of School parking was again subject to discussion and Cncllr Anthony Hopkins reported that the Highways Authority were considering a number of options. The absence of an official "School Crossing" officer was a real issue.

It was reported that the work to resurface the large section of the footpath 643 connecting to Tuer Way was soon to start, making it accessible for wheelchairs and pushchairs. The Lengthsman was starting work again, subject to Covid-19 safety conditions, and would be asked to clear the pavement from The Old Bakery to Stockwood Lane junction and to clear the road names at the Stonepits cross roads.

The Police reported that there had been an aborted theft of a motor home in Wityhed Lane and an attempted theft at a farm in Kington.

It was noted that the new 'Bus Timetable had not been completely finalised but it appeared that No: 150 was running but requested for essential use only. 97% of the County Schools were now open. The County Council had a number of Transport Schemes/Proposals being considered that would be Government funded.

The Bottle Banks at the Village Hall car park had been causing problems, with boxes of bottles being left on the ground because the bank was full. The clear glass bank seemed to be the culprit, but bottles left on the ground had been broken, causing a safety issue. The addition of a 2nd clear glass bank would be investigated but on the meantime **we are all asked not to leave bottles in the car park when the banks are full.**

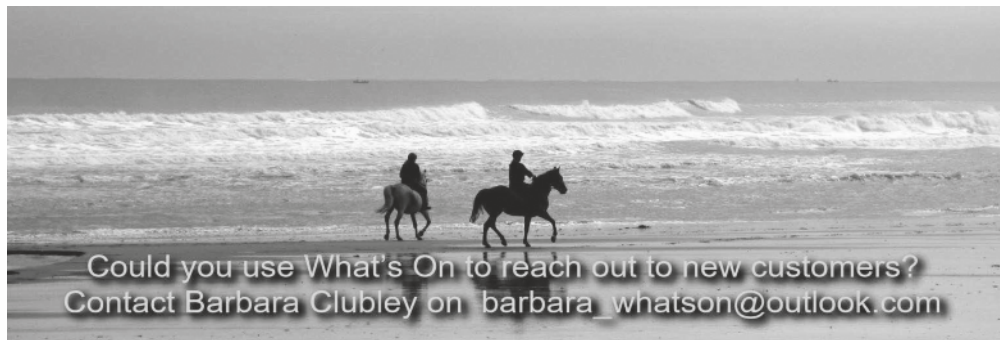



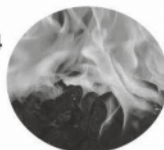
