Welcome! This year we welcomed our new Head Teacher, Mr Glenn Duggan, who has settled in really well. Mr Duggan has supported the school through its crucial transition to primary status and has led us brilliantly during the coronavirus pandemic. We are very grateful to Mr Duggan for his leadership and would also like to take this opportunity to congratulate him on the arrival of Dolcie, sister to Kai.



Staffing Update It was lovely welcoming Mrs Done back from her maternity leave but we were sad to see Mrs Cooke and Mrs Crawford leave us this year. We



wish them both all the best in their new ventures. We miss you! Thank you to Mrs McPherson for her role in Acting Deputy Head Teacher this year and to Mr Knight for his role in the Senior Leadership Team.

Congratulations to Miss Yates who successfully completed her NQT year, Mrs Nock for achieving her Supporting Teaching and Learning Level 3 and to Miss Holliday for completing her NASENCO Award. All fantastic achievements, especially given the circumstances this year!

In September, we look forward to welcoming 30 new Wrens to Inkberrow Primary School, as well as Mr Todd Geary as our Year 6 Teacher, and Ann-Marie and James Booton who will be providing Forest School and specialist music lessons.



Enhancements Before the pandemic hit, the school was busy introducing a number of new things: a new curriculum design including year 5 curriculum, knowledge organisers, house points, Top 100 book challenge, Purple Mash and a new Facebook page. We have also been using our Lottery Bid funding to develop a community garden.



After school enrichment activities included drama, choir, dance, street dance, tennis, football, basketball and netball. We thank the staff who give their free time to support these activities. The school was proud to be awarded with the Primary Science Quality Mark and to be nominated as a school member of the Music Mark. **The Pandemic!** 'Normal' operations have clearly been significantly impacted by the coronavirus pandemic and the directed closure of schools. Mr Duggan and his team reacted quickly to the ever-changing Government guidance and have provided high quality home learning plans alongside additional whole school learning activities. They kept the school open for key worker children and welcomed back certain year groups towards the end of the summer term, as and when the Government guidance has allowed. The measures put in place within the school environment have been excellent and the children



have coped brilliantly with the new procedures. We received some lovely comments from parents about the home schooling provision and are really proud of how well the children have adapted.



Friends of Inkberrow Primary Activity Prior to March, FOIP raised money at movie nights, a murder mystery evening, Halloween and Christmas parties, and via sponsorship for a relay race in the village. We are so grateful at how FOIP have reacted during this pandemic, thinking creatively to continue fundraising in different ways. This has included sales of Easter eggs and a virtual Alice in Wonderland



summer fete. These activities have contributed to a total of just under £4,500 funds raised throughout the year. This support is invaluable to the school. THOUGHT FOR THE MONTH By Rev'd Bruce Rienstra Vicar of the Benefice of Inkberrow with Cookhill and Kington with Dormston



At a time when so much is not as it should be, or at the very least a time when things are quite different to what we are used to, it is only natural that people are looking for something to hold on to, something to trust.

Not unsurprisingly you'll be expecting me to continue with something along the lines of, the "constancy of God" or to quote from the hymn that "all my hope on God is founded". Whilst both of these statements are quite true I want to take a slightly different tack.

Much of what we do we do out of habit, we do things because it's always been done that way and the difficult time we are currently in is challenging many of our norms and habits. The pubs were closed, hairdressers closed, sports clubs closed, there were no sports on tele, broadcasters ran out of episodes of our favourite soaps, all those "normal" things were gone. Many didn't even have to go to work, people worked from home or those in the care sector working hours became extremely long and dangerous. Church services were cancelled for the first time since the civil war, before that it was because of the plague in the 13th century. A few months ago many of us couldn't get a delivery slot for our favourite supermarket, forcing us to try another.

How often do we hear of "the new normal" and what will it be like? Personally I don't think it will be all bad. I think we can and will have learned a lot from the experience of the last several months and the many months to come. There has been a wonderful community spirit, and with more people working from home perhaps the dormitory feel of our villages will lessen, the lessons on how to do the same things we used to do but do them differently will lead to new skills and greater flexibility. We'll appreciate our village amenities more, the local pubs and their food, the sports and social clubs and all they offer and the local entertainment when it starts again.

In the meantime let's be thankful for the many people and services which have helped us all through these last six months, the first responders, the doctors' surgery, carers and helpers, too many to mention but all those who have made a positive impact and have lessened the severity of "lockdown".

Go into the "new normal" feeling positive, continuing to hold on to that whatever for you "the constancy of God" means and on what your hope is founded. I know what that means for me, do you?

Inkberrow Parish Council

The latest Parish Council meeting was held on 19th August 2020 via web cam.

Cncllr. David Hunter reported that most of the problems in regard to the ownership and responsibility of maintenance in the Ross Crescent and footpath 635 areas had at last been solved, with the waste bin to be emptied regularly. The hand rail at the steps to the Church from Pepper Street had been repaired. A number of pavements throughout the village were requiring weed clearance, but the safe distancing for this work to be carried out was causing a problem. It was noted that some repair work on the pavement in Stonepit Lane would shortly start.

The Neighbourhood Plan Group hoped to commence meetings soon, which had been delayed due to the Covid 19 restrictions. The Group were seeking help in recognising specific trees of note throughout the Parish which should be preserved. The trees would need to be photographed and recorded in order that they would not be lost in future development. Cncllr Mrs. Audrey Steel will obtain detail of all the trees in the Parish already with a TPO.

Police Report. Again, although requested, a Police Report had not been received. However, it was noted that an attempted break-in had occurred in the Stonepits area.

County Councillor Anthony Hopkins reported the CC had a good record of responding rapidly to all Covid-19 emergencies as they had arisen, with very few cases currently being recorded in Worcestershire. Cncllr Hopkins would make enquiries in regard to the progress being made to alleviate flooding in the Withybed Lane area and would report the blocked drain on the A422.

The area already has problems with road parking and was under survey by the Highways Authority.

20/01099 (amendment). Member failed to see from the drawings what the amendment entailed. Clerk would request more detail but PC would express support for an Archaeological report.

The telephone box would be given a facelift and repaint as soon as a contractor can be found. All PC owned street furniture will be given an annual inspection.

Motorbike speeding. It was agreed the PC would write to John Campion regarding this ongoing problem and would engage with surrounding Parish Councils in an effort to reduce this nuisance.






