Schedule of classes

Hyacinths

1. Three bulbs

Narcissi

- 2. Daffodils (long trumpet) five bulbs, single (one flower per stem)
- 3. Daffodils (small cup) five bulbs, single (one flower per stem)
- 4. Five bulbs, double (one flower per stem)
- 5. Five bulbs, multi flowered, single
- 6. Five bulbs, multi flowered, double

Tulips

- 7. Five bulbs, single
- 8. Five bulbs, double

Crocus

9. Bowl of crocus, any single variety

Other bulbs & corms

- 10. Bowl of any variety of bulbs or corms not in the above classes
- 11. Bowl of miniature bulbs, any variety, not exceeding 10" in height from soil level

Amaryllis

12. One bulb

Pot plants

- 13. Pot plant, foliage
- 14. Pot plant, flowering
- 15. Three or more decorative plants grown in a container

Cacti

16. Specimen cactus or succulent

Cut flowers

- 17. One stem specimen bloom daffodils, any type
- 18. Three stems of one variety of trumpet daffodils
- 19. Three stems of one variety of small cup daffodils
- 20. Vase of polyanthus, minimum five stems
- 21. Stem of hellebore
- 22. Flower head of hellebore floating in water
- 23. Collection of spring flowers, not less than four varieties (outdoor grown)
- 24. One spray of spring flowering shrub
- 25. Arrangement of spring flowers (no size constraint)
- 26. Miniature arrangement of spring flowers (maximum overall dimensions: 9" high, 9" deep & 9" wide)
- 27. Six pansy heads in a vase

Where possible, please label the variety of the bulb grown Honorary exhibits which fall outside the listed classes will be welcome

- A: Spring Table centrepiece to your own design
- B: Allotments winter products
- **C:** Children 'Picture of Spring Flowers' Under 5's 5 to 9 years

Awards

The **Ansell Challenge Cup** will be awarded to the exhibitor with the highest number of points in the bulb section.

The Society Challenge Cup will be awarded to the exhibitor with the highest total number of points.

An award in memory of Grace and Derek Seymour will be presented to the Society member with the 'Best in Show' exhibit.

Rules

- 1. All exhibits in the bulb classes must be grown by the exhibitor.
- 2. All entries in the pot plant classes must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least three months.
- 3. All classes are open to non members, but cups may only be won by Society members.
- 4. Entries are to be in one name only.
- 5. Exhibitors may be awarded more than one prize in any class. Points will be awarded as follows:

First 4 points
Second 3 points
Third 2 points
Highly Commended 1 point

6. Exhibitors are requested to avoid moving or disturbing other competitors' entries. If there is insufficient space for your entry, please ask a steward for assistance.

Cups must be returned to the Society Chairman by the date of the next Spring Flower Show (2025).
