Thought for the Month

His Grace is Sufficient

The trauma suffered by so many people, as a result of the Post Office Horizon IT scandal, has been without precedent. Hundreds of lives have been affected. A wave of anger was released at the injustice suffered by so many sub-postmasters and their families. In some cases, this has led to tragic loss of life. Another tragedy of recent memory was the suicide of headteacher, Ruth Perry, resulting from the Ofsted pressures she was subjected to during her school's Inspection.



20 years ago, Kevin, a homeless teenager came to make a home with us. He had been helped considerably by Redditch Nightstop. This charity offers support, care and short-term accommodation with host families for young people who face homelessness. In his last year of sixth form, Kevin was preparing for university when he settled with us. He proceeded to the University of Birmingham, where he achieved first class honours in applied mathematics and theoretical physics and then a PhD in theoretical physics, followed by three years post-doctoral research. Whilst in the 6th form, he had become a Christian believer and his faith was to play a major role in his future life.

After 11 years in Birmingham, he chose to enter school teaching. He enjoyed creatively five years at a prestigious, part-boarding school in London. He qualified on-the-job as a teacher of physics. Kevin then moved to a well-known public day school. He also helped organise the national Physics Olympiad in Oxford. Sadly, a pupil safeguarding scenario at his previous school led to an investigation. The stress of this during early 2023 and the injustice of the process, caused a severe breakdown, with tragic and fatal results at Easter. The day after his death, it was announced that he was totally blameless of any offence! The sorrow and grief at his loss was not limited to our own and his natural family, but countless friends, colleagues and former pupils many of whom communicated with us in such positive ways.

On reflection, we realise how privileged we were to share in twenty or so years of Kevin's life and share our family life with him. We are thankful that we have so many happy memories of him, were able to learn so much from him and help him along the pathway of a notable, if tragically foreshortened, career in education.

At Easter, we remember God's only son, Jesus, who also died as a young man through the unjust and brutal death on a cross. That was not, however, the end. We learn from the Scriptures he rose to life again. Jesus Christ opened a pathway to all who trust in him to receive eternal life, extending beyond our human existence. Those who follow Jesus, however, are not exempt from suffering unjustly in this imperfect world.

PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD IN THE PAVILION, SANDS ROAD, ON WEDNESDAY 20TH MARCH, 2014, THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING WAS HELD.

THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING. Six members of the public attended. The Parish Council Chairman presented the Parish Council report referring to the various topics that had to be dealt with during the past year, including the very controversial planning application for a Solar Farm at Stockwood where the planning decision was still awaited and the problems Airband brought into the village. The PC had been happy to welcome Elizabeth Jordan as a new Parish Councillor following the elections last year, together with Nick Dawkes and Ben Hurdman, our new District Councillors. We also welcomed a new Lengthsman and the village had been fortunate to have had the benefit of numerous works carried out, both refurbishing and creating new additions to the village by the Men's Shed group. Graffiti and litter continued to be a menace, but the volunteer litter pickers are very much appreciated. **Speeding** throughout the village on the A442, Withybed Lane and Windmill Lane was on going with PC contact with the Community Police Team. A number of flooding issues had been dealt with and trees around the village had needed attention. The entrance to the car park had been improved and the car park and Play Area were ongoing projects this year. Sadly, two outstanding ex Members of the Parish Council had passed away this year, Councillors Gordon Moone and Audrey Steel – both had also been District Councillors. Our Clerk has retired after 38 years and we are looking to fill the vacancy by next month. The Parish Charities report was received and with so few parishioners making a claim the total monies held in the Charity currently stands at £3,976.22.

INKBERROW PARISH COUNCIL MEETING. Discussion took place regarding the **flooding in Stonepit Lane.** The Planning Enforcement Officer was investigating the cause. **The Play Area refurbishment** was expected to be completed by June. The County Councillor's contribution from her CC **Discretionary Fund** was still awaited.

Planning The following planning applications were considered: W/24/00373/FUL Mearse Croft, Mearse Lane. Retrospective and new permission sought for agricultural buildings including grain silos, chicken sheds and movable hen houses (Removal of condition 3 ref 21/02986/FUL.) Approved provided a noise test is carried out regarding the retention of the generator. W/24/00344 and 00345. Step Hill, Stockwood Lane. Ext. to rear of existing detached garage to provide additional garage/workshop with storage over. Approved. W/24/00283/FUL. Torite. Stockwood Lane. Proposed single storey ext. new vehicular access and driveway ext. Approved provided Highways were in agreement. W/24/00288/CLE. All Saints Barn, Stockwood Lane. Change of use. Recommended refusal on the grounds that it was believed insufficient time had passed to prove there is no demand for a live/work unit in this location.

The **Parish Council notice board** has reached the end of its usefulness and needs to be replaced. In the meantime, PC notices will be placed in the village notice board. The Parish Games are underway and grateful thanks to Steve for his work with organising the Games.

The map case has been removed from its place by the Village Green and will soon be refurbished and returned to continue guiding walkers around the miles of footpaths around the village. Our thanks to the Men's Shed for doing this work.

The next Parish Council meeting is scheduled for Wednesday 17th April, 2024, commencing at 7.30pm.

On a personal note, and as stated previously, I will, this month, be retiring from post of Clerk for Inkberrow Parish Council. I have met so many people and made so many friends over the years and being involved with so many projects within this beautiful village has been nothing less than a great honour. Thank you all for your kindness and good wishes. Janet.

Inkberrow Parish Council has said farewell and thank you to Janet Cresswell, who has acted as clerk to the Parish Council for the last 38 years.

The Parish Council will miss her and wish her well in her retirement.

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Cookhill Allotments Update

There are currently two vacancies. One of the vacant plots will become a new wildlife area, with small shrubs that will hopefully attract butterflies and bees to the site.

The committee are no longer considering extending the car park, the hard core has been removed from the area to make space for additional vehicles.

The mains water will be turned on for testing during the first week in April. The site now has the benefit of an underground stop tap to enable the supply to be quickly turned off in the event of a leak or for repairs.

The mower and strimmers have all been serviced ready for the start of the new season.

Cookhill Village Hall – Friday Coffee Mornings

As many parishioners will know, Cllr Sumner has been running a very successful Coffee Morning at the Hall on Friday mornings, from 10am until noon. Unfortunately, the much used hot water boiler at the Hall has recently broken beyond repair and the Parish Council have agreed to assist with the purchase of a new one.

The Parish Council planted 10 trees in Kington & Dormston last year, unfortunately 1 died and 4 were destroyed, the Clerk is looking into costs for replacing the trees.

The Parish Council thanked Neighbourhood Watch for all the time and energy spent on trying to get Smart water rolled out in the village.

Unfortunately, only 66 properties registered interest in the initiative and 103 properties would need to register the kits in order for the village to receive the Smart Water signage which is a big deterrent. It was therefore agreed to only fund the scheme if Neighbourhood Watch are willing to go door to door in the village and register kits on doorsteps- this is for the group's consideration.

The Police are still looking for possible hard standing spaces along the A422 to safely conduct speed checks- do you have any land or openings along the side of the road that could be used?

Please contact the clerk if so.

The issue was raised about the need for more bins in both Kington and Dormston especially for dog walkers and so the Parish Council are looking into this currently.

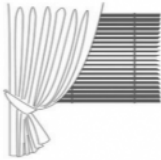

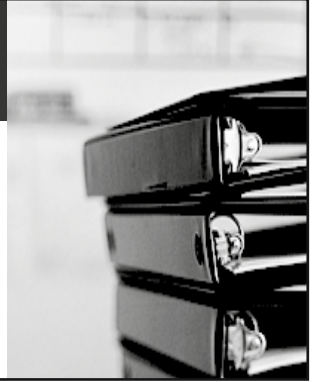

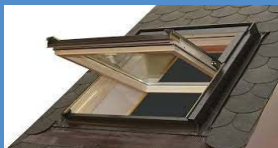
