

Thought for the Month

By Rev'd Ian Perry, Priest in Charge of the Benefice of Inkberrow with Cookhill and Kington with Dormston

Dear friends,

At the end of March, we celebrated Easter in our four churches and many people gathered in churches across the land to celebrate the risen Christ. I have been thinking of explaining what the church services are we offer across the benefice and what is involved with them.

The most well-known service within the Church of England and is offered across the benefice is Holy Communion, sometimes called The Eucharist or The Lord's Supper. This commemorates the Last Supper where Jesus shared a meal of bread and wine with his disciples.

During the Last Supper, Jesus took bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." He also took a cup of wine, blessed it, and gave it to them, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood.". This service often includes hymns of praise and thanksgiving alongside prayer, bible readings and a talk or sermon by the minister. Jesus says to his disciples 'Do this in remembrance of me' so that is why we celebrate communion where we remember all that Jesus did for us in going to the cross.

On the first Sunday of the month at 8am in St Peter's Inkberrow we have a Book of Common Prayer Communion Service. This service uses traditional language and is without hymns and singing. The service is quite meditative and allows those attending to spend time with God, receive communion in a quieter way. A BCP Communion service is characterized by its reverence, use of formal language, and adherence to traditional liturgical forms, providing a sense of continuity with the historical worship practices of the church.

We also have services across the benefice of Morning Praise often called a morning worship service or morning prayer service. It typically takes place early in the day and is designed to start the day off with worship/hymns, prayer, and reflection but communion is not celebrated at these services. They are often led by Lay members of the church or Readers (Not ordained).

On the first and third Sundays of the month we have a service at 11am in the PEC behind St Peter's Inkberrow aptly named Church @ 11. This service uses modern contemporary worship songs and is more relaxed and informal. On the fourth Sunday we gather again in the PEC at 11am to watch a recorded service

from St Aldates in Oxford where we join in with their singing and listen to what they have recorded for that week. On all the Church @ 11 services we look to the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives and how do we respond.

My belief is with the range of services that we offer then there will be a service that you will feel comfortable attending and finding out what God has in store for you.

In all our services we aim to meet with God and allow him to minister to us in which ever way we need at the time. Anyone is welcome to attend any or all our services and if you would like to know more then please do get in touch with me.



April Meeting of Inkberrow Parish Council Was Held in The Pavilion, Sands Road, 17th April 2024.

During the fifteen-minute public speaking session prior to the opening of the PC meeting we heard from a representative from Roundhill Wood Solar Farm Opposition Group (RWSFOG) regarding the latest plans that have been submitted, and the support being offered. There were also a number of concerns heard over the development in Stonepit Lane.

Highways – it was noted that the signs, once again, had gone from the Worcester Bend. The road is going to be closed at the beginning of May for a new road surface to be laid.

The Relay Race - would take place on 19th May, 2024, starting and finishing at the football grounds.

New Fencing would be installed at the play area once the weather allows.

Parish Council Notice Board – This had been taken down due to being unsafe, a new board will be ordered from the same company that supplied the events notice board, and the Men's Shed will install this. Thanks were given the ClIr E Jordan for the prompt removal of the old board once it was deemed unsafe.

The **lengthsman** will be asked to continue the monthly tasks, but home owners are also reminded that they are responsible for any hedges that boundary onto public rights of way and to make sure these are safe for people to walk along.

Planning - W/24/00157/FUL Land Off Barley Meadows Inkberrow—refer back to original statement, over development of the site. W/24/00633/FUL Land at (OS 0246 5916)

Holberrow Green— Not enough information to make a comment. W/24/00638/FUL Bouts

Corner Farm Bouts Lane Holberrow Green - Not enough information to make a comment.

The Parish Council has not been advised of what work is going be going on here. It was noted that we have reservations about the number and vagueness of the work aspect, of these work live units coming through recently. W/24/00420/FUL Football And Cricket

Pitches Sands Road — It is understood that these were previously included in planning, but it was felt that planners need to be made aware once again that the car park does not belong to the football club, and parking is still a contention. W/24/00730/RM Long

Meadow Farm Holberrow Green — The original planning recommended an agricultural tie, the Parish council has no objections as long as it complies with the Agricultural Occupancy Condition

Our District Councillors advised that Out of Hours support is now being handled by Redditch and Bromsgrove CCTV service on 01527 912966. The Out of Hours Emergency number is to be used only for emergencies, for example, traveller encampments on council land. It was also noted that the Men's Shed would be looking to replace the wood on the bench round the tree on the village green.

Summary from the Cookhill Parish Council Meeting held in the conference room at SE Davis, Sandhills Farm, Edgioake Lane on **Tuesday 9**th **April 2024**

Prior to the commencement of the Parish Council Meeting the Annual Parish Meeting was held.

COOKHILL ANNUAL PARISH MEETING UPDATE

The Parish Council Chairman presented his annual report. He welcomed the two new District Councillors, Cllr Ben Hurdman and Cllr Nick Dawkes

Cookhill had a difficult task to replace their Lengthsman in 2023 but are happy to finally welcome someone new to the role. He has now carried out the necessary training and is officially allowed to work on the highway.

The Parish Council continue to receive planning applications. The experienced team of councillors, look at the applications on arrival and make their recommendations. The Chairman reiterated that the Parish Council can only advise and pass on their recommendations. The results of planning applications are ultimately decided by a delegated team of salaried planning officers at Wychavon.

A very successful Coffee Morning, held every Friday at the Village Hall, was started by Cllr Sumner. Since the pandemic a lot of residents had started to feel isolated in their own homes with no opportunity to meet up with friends and neighbours. Recently the Parish Council have combined the Coffee Mornings with roadshows from the Police and Wychavon and they hope to add more specialist events in 2024. The Coffee Morning runs from 10am until Midday every Friday.

There are currently 2 vacant plots at the site with the

potential for three more in the near future, interested parties can contact the clerk or the allotment association chairman to put their names on the waiting list. Details on the Parish Council website. The Parish Council wished to thank Mr David Claydon and the Allotment Association for their ongoing hard work at the site.




