

Clerk's Report

Notice Boards – The parish notice boards are slowly being renovated and replaced. The new board at the bottom of Church Lane is now in place and the board at the Village Hall currently due for replacement.

Red Telephone Box – Unfortunately, it looks like the re-siting of the Parish Council owned red telephone box will not be taking place, due to logistical concerns.

Cookhill Allotments Update

Plot 35 is still vacant, plus half of Plot 31 which will make up 3 new plots.

The annual Parish Council awarded trophy for best kept allotment has been handed to the tenants at 10a.

Due to the wet weather it has not been possible to level the ground on the burning plot or to start work on the wildlife area.

Hedge cutting – This will be completed in the coming weeks, weather permitting and the hedges at the bottom of the Parish Fields will need to be assessed for repair in the coming months.

Defibrillators & Bleed Control Cabinet / Kits

Following the last meeting the Chairman did a complete check of the four Cookhill defibrillators. It was ascertained that the heating in two of the older cabinets is no longer working, meaning that the battery life of the defibrillators / pads is shorter than they should be. The council agreed to the purchase of two new cabinets for these locations.

The cabinets can be located at the Cookhill Village Hall, Nevill Arms, Rooftop flats (the Ridgeway) and SE Davis Ltd. on Edgioake Lane.

The new Bleed Control cabinet and kits will soon be installed on the outside of the Village Hall. next to the defibrillator.

Parish Initiatives

The council agreed that a back would be installed in the bus shelter outside the Village Hall as it is well used and this will make it a little more weather-proof. The original glass back was smashed a few years ago so a safer alternative will be researched.

Parish Paths

The finger post at the entrance to the Allotments has rotted and is on the ground, it has been reported to the Parish Paths Warden for repair.

A parishioner reported that the post on the kissing gate on Chamberlain Lane has rotted away over the Christmas break, making it hard to access the path. This has been reported to the PROWS Team and the Parish Paths Warden, who has agreed to repair the post when the weather improves.

New Trees for Platinum Meadows

The Parish Council agreed the purchase of some replacement trees for the ones that didn't survive at Platinum Meadows. They are looking for about thirty mixed trees.

Kington & Dormston Parish Council

Summary from the Parish Council Meeting held at the Village Hall on Monday $13^{\rm th}$ January 2025.

There is a A422 Safety Meeting planned at 7.30pm on Thursday 21st January with John Campion (PCC) and Marc Bayliss due to attend. The meeting will be held at the Flyford's Hall, Grafton Flyford, WR7 4PG, it is public meeting and parishioners are invited to attend.

Decisions have been reached to extend the age ranges of all the first schools in the Pershore Education Planning Area to become Primary schools. The middle schools in Pershore will no longer have a point of entry into Year 5 for September 2025, and Pershore High School's intake will be expanded to accommodate all Year 7 pupils in the area from September 2027. More information about these changes is available at https://www.worcestershire.gov.uk/pershorereview

Devolution- Prior to Christmas the government announced major changes to how local government will operate in the years to come, following the publication of its White Paper. Nothing has been decided but the government's intent seems to be clear- please see meeting minutes for more details.

Following concerns from residents and the Parish Council Police collected speed data along Cockshot Lane between 13/11/24 and 20/11/24 and the average speed was 27mph and the *85th percentile speed (Speed at which 85% of vehicles were travelling at or below) was 31mph. Motorists compliance was therefore deemed to be generally good. This would not fall into the enforcement criteria by West Mercia Police. The Parish Council however, are still considering an additional VAS machine in this area.


