Defibrillators - Lifesavers for bystanders

Inkberrow village is fortunate to have 2 defibrillators that are fully functioning and registered with the National Defibrillator Network – The Circuit. The Circuit has been developed by the British Heart Foundation (BHF) and is a National Defibrillator database that ambulance services are connected to. This provides Ambulance Control Centres across the UK with the devices' locations, which can then be provided to 999 callers when reporting a cardiac arrest emergency.

At the time of a call, Control Centre Staff ensure Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) has commenced and will advise the defibrillator's location. This helps to ensure rescues are in line with the Chain of Survival, ensuring chest compressions are delivered whilst a defibrillator is located.

Defibrillation, combined with effective CPR is the only form of treatment for cardiac arrest casualties. Providing treatment within 3-5 minutes of collapse increases the survival chance from 6% to 74%.

Always phone 999/112 if you witness a cardiac arrest emergency or are asked to by a person needing help. The ambulance service will describe the location and code to access the defibrillator and they will send an ambulance as well.



From Rev'd Ian Perry, Priest in Charge of the Benefice of Inkberrow with Cookhill and Kington with Dormston



As March unfolds, the season of Lent is upon us, beginning on Ash Wednesday on March 5th—a season of profound spiritual significance, inviting us to reflect, repent, and renew our faith. 

Meeting of Parish Council held February 19th 2025

The Parish Council would like to thank all the volunteer litter pickers who have been active this last fortnight. It makes an enormous difference to our village and one to be proud of.

We are working with Wychavon and Worcester County Council Highways to resolve a couple of litter and parking issues within the village. As the reporting Clerk I'm really pleased to be working with supportive staff, at both levels, who have all been very helpful and informative. Sometimes 'hands are tied' but often it is the process of receiving information and being able to pass it on that is to be considered a win.

Changes afoot in local government

In Worcestershire, there are three tiers of councils in local government. Worcestershire County Council that deals with issues such as child and adult social care, Highways, Education and Waste Disposal. The District, City or Borough Council is the second tier of Council that deals with issues such as household waste collection, housing and planning. The other tier of local government is Town and Parish Councils who have wide-ranging powers to better the place you live, such as putting on events, community hanging baskets and planters, taking care of community buildings, play areas and monuments.

The government's English Devolution White Paper 'Power and Partnerships, Foundations for Growth' published in December 2024 stated that the government wants all areas in England to be eventually restructured into single tier unitary authorities. This continues a trend over several decades towards larger, single tier local governments in England; some restructuring has already taken place.

The government expects that this restructuring will lead to fewer, larger councils in England. For most areas, this will mean creating Councils with a population of 500,000 or more but there may be exceptions to ensure the new structures make sense for an area.

The timeframe from a locality submitting a proposal for unitary local government to delivering the new authority is typically 2 1/2 years. The White Paper says that the government will consider postponing upcoming elections to existing councils where a restructure is agreed.

There is no mechanism for the public to support or oppose restructuring through a petition or a referendum.

It is not clear from available evidence where unitary councils will save money compared with current tiered structure systems. However, in England, estimates published by reputable consultants suggest that unitary councils could save £20 to £25 million annually.

As with all change, there will be opportunities for local councils to develop and take on the provision of some services currently provided at 'district' level and your local councils will welcome your thoughts and opinions on the forthcoming changes.

The village has benefited from 4 new trees planted as part of a county-wide grant-funded planting scheme called the Local Authority Treescape Fund. The Government funded 'Nature for Climate' fund is administered by the Forestry Commission and is aimed at local authorities to increase tree cover outside of Woodlands in both rural and urban landscapes.

The trees will be maintained for the next 3 years during their establishment phase, each tree being visited every 2 weeks from April to September. When they have reached independence the trees will then form part of WCC routine highway inspection.

These trees are going to enhance the street scene of the village considerably. The species for the scheme have been carefully selected for each site and the trees in Inkberrow offer many different qualities throughout the seasons, the autumn colours all trees display are stunning. The trees are Sorbus Commmixta, Liquidambar Styraciflua, Tilia Cordata, and Corylus Colurna. Safer Neighbourhood Team

Vicky Elliott our Safer Neighbourhood Team Officer reported a number of vehicle and trailer thefts in the area and advised that physical deterrents such as crook locks were becoming increasingly popular with the public.

Vicky also agreed that it may be useful for the Council to share and discuss the vehicle speed and number data from our VAS radar signs with the team to improve village safety.

Neighbourhood Plan

The Parish Council acknowledged that an enormous amount of time and effort had gone into developing the Neighbourhood Plan. The local volunteers and experts who have worked tirelessly on this were sincerely thanked. Following a long discussion it was agreed, with the unitary authority changes and differences in opinion that were voiced, the Council was best placed to preserve the document and maintain a watchful wait approach.

Precept

It was noted that the precept had been set by Wychavon at a 3.4% increase which compares favourably with other councils and allows the Council to continue its work on behalf of the Village.

Play Areas

Some new ground bark and further repair works were due in the Sands Road Play Area and RoSPA safety inspection is also due. The Council will also be looking to replace the 'much loved' tractor for our children.
