





Inkberrow Parish Council Meeting April 16th 2025

There were no public questions this meeting and seven members of the public were in attendance. We also had another full complement of Councillors.

There were a number of **Highways matters** to note:

- Worcestershire County Council (WCC) are closing Holberrow Green road to repair the highway on May 7th for 1 day.
- WCC are closing Middle Road Stock Green on May 13th 2025 for 1 day for Airband to work
- Chaston Close Footway reconstruction will be underway for 6 days from May 6th 2025
- Churchway Piece will be closed on May 6th for 4 days to allow a new customer connection by Cadent Gas
- Stockwood Lane will be closed on May 1st for 2 days to allow a dropped kerb to be installed
- The parking prohibition on Stockwood Lane to improve safety and vehicular access has been approved following consultation with the public and authorities.
- The partial road collapse on Priory Farm
 Lane towards Church Hill has been reported many, many times by the Parish Council. WCC Highways have advised that they are determining land ownership and progressing a repair. They have advised that this is likely to take time and they have allocated an inspector to monitor the condition of the road in the meantime.

BES and Solar Farm Stock Green Planning Portal and the PC have a hard copy for local review for those with no internet access.

There were no **Police reports**, but a couple of vehicle thefts were reported in nearby Stock and Bradley Green. There was also a theft of equipment from the business park in Inkberrow Village.

There was no report from the County Councillor, and it was noted that elections are due to take place so our Parish will welcome a new County Councillor in May.

Our **District Councillor** sent a comprehensive report. It detailed that the seven Worcestershire councils submitted the interim plan for Local Government Reorganisation on governmental changes.

He asked that villagers noted that the Wychavon Rural Grant has now reopened and all information can be found on the Wychavon website.

Ben also detailed that the Government announced major reforms to the planning system through the tabling of its Planning and Infrastructure Bill and he reported the examination phase of the South Worcestershire Development Plan Review (SWDPR) started on 4 March, with public hearings taking place at the Guildhall in Worcester.

The report will be on Inkberrow Website for you to peruse.

Our **Finance Officer** reported that the Year End accounts had been prepared and there was a very small surplus.

There are a number of **Planning Applications**

- a. W/25/00430/FUL Inkberrow Football and Cricket Pavillion, Sands Road. Installation of practice facility with nets
- b. W/25/00621/FUL Land and Buildings at Stockwood, Inkberrow Construction of 1 No live/ work unit
- W/24/02606/FUL Hindle Wakes Stockwood Inkberrow. Change of use of land and replacement of existing timber stables and separate blockwork garage outbuilding for ancillary accommodation, detached garage and greenhouse
- d. Note W/25/00422/PIP Bouts Corner Farm Bouts Lane. PIP Demolition of house and buildings and erection of up to 5 dwellings was Approved

You may have noticed that the play area on Sands Road has received a refresh of the bark. We are very grateful to Councillors Neale and Jordan who arranged this and all those who helped Jane, Elizabeth and Rodger put the bark into the play area.

Allotments update. Many allotment holders are busy tidying up and working on their plots which is very encouraging and pleasing to see. We have a beautiful asset in our village and all the allotments are let. If you'd like to go on the waiting list, then please contact the Clerk You may have noticed the pile of **litter pick** bags on the Village Green. This litter was collected on the sunniest morning of Sunday April 6th by many villagers and their children. Thank you everyone on an amazing job. If you are interested in future litter picks let the Clerk know. The dates are also announced on the Parish Council Noticeboard.

Thank you to Cllr Griffin who attended the **A422 Safety Meeting**. There were a number of actions as a result of this that will be carried forward by the Deputy Police Commissioner and our local County Councillor.

The next meeting is the Annual Parish Council meeting on 21st May 2025 at 7.30pm in the Bowls Pavillion, Sands Lane.

Summary from the Cookhill Parish Council Meeting held in the conference room at SE Davis, Sandhills Farm, Edgioake Lane on **Tuesday 8**th **April 2025**
