



# Thought for the Month

### LIGHT OUT OF DARKNESS



How many of us have travelled through those dark times in life? Perhaps an illness, loss of a loved one, an accident of some sort, a broken relationship, a setback or redundancy in career, a dream unfilled, or even a house- move? How do we cope?

In the Bible New Testament are recorded the experiences of the disciples and friends of Jesus. They were confronted at the first Pentecost-Easter with the death by brutal crucifixion of their leader – what a dark time for them! Then Jesus had risen from the dead and over some 40 days he was seen by and spoken with numerous people. After tragedy, he offered encouragement, hope and a future – light rather than tragedy.

However, his earthly days were limited. On what we call Ascension Day, Jesus passed bodily into heaven to be with Father God – his passing another dark time for his followers. Jesus promised that his followers would experience God's presence in a new way not limited to one place, through the gift of God's Holy Spirit. As promised, 10 days after Ascension, Jesus's promise was fulfilled with the spontaneous anointing of the believers with the Holy Spirit, recorded in Acts Chapter 2 – another enlightening experience. This event in Jerusalem was the initiation of the Christian Church, which has spread worldwide over many centuries. Jesus's followers had experienced yet again the darkness of losing a friend. But at Pentecost, the coming of the Holy Spirit was a new light into their lives.

We too can experience light into our darkest days by allowing Jesus through his Holy Spirit into our lives.

The forthcoming annual Flower Festival at Cookhill Baptist Church, during the last week in June, will be illustrating the theme of "*Light out of Darkness*".

### Meeting May 21<sup>st</sup> 2025

There were no public questions this meeting and the Solar Farm Planning Application was discussed as an agenda item and 4 members of the public were in attendance. There were no **Police reports** Congratulations to David Hunter on his re-election to Chair and Robin Lunn on his election to Vice Chair. Thank you to David and Jane Neale, our outgoing vice Chair, and all of our Parish Councillors for supporting our community in their voluntary capacities.

Following recent elections our Parish has a new County Councillor. The Clerk welcomed Satinder Bell to our monthly meetings and will be discussing the Parish Council priorities in the near future.

There were a number of **Highways matters** to note:

The parking prohibition on Stockwood Lane to improve safety and vehicular access has been completed

The partial road collapse on Priory Farm Lane towards Church Hill has been inspected and no safety issues raised, investigations into resolution continue

The road surface on Appletree Lane outside Little Norbury Farm has been assessed by WCC and orders raised for the necessary repairs

The deterioration of verges on Stockwood Lane to Alcester Road (Pinhills) has been referred to WCC Highways engineering to look into possibility of applying bollards / verge masters or lining at the location

The 'Inkberrow' sign is missing at the end of the village will be reported to WCC

A water leak on Earls Common Road between Sands Road and A422 will be reported to STW The speed of traffic through Holberrow Green was discussed and our PCSO, V Elliott, is looking into some 'speed' bars to monitor car speed. Our **District Councillor** reported that training sessions for Parish and town Councils was underway on Digital Fundraising for Town/Parish Councils and Village Halls. As part of WDC new promise to develop five new community youth projects in rural areas some new detached work is taking place. YMCA Worcestershire will be out and about in rural areas across the district over the next year to check in with young people and find out what is going on for them in their local area. The contact for more information about this exciting community resource please contact <u>robin.mace@wychavon.gov.uk</u>It was acknowledged that there is a backlog in process Planning Applications, due to volume attributed to a pending price increase, a number of BHs and other unavoidable instances. WDC staff are working hard to clear the backlog. The final week of public examination of the SWDPR completed, various matters were completed and the hearings closed for now. The Planning Inspectorate raised the prospect of further hearings in September on ecology and transportation. Latest news on <u>www.localplanservices.co.uk/swdpreview</u>The rural grant application end date has been extended to June 9<sup>th</sup> 2025.

Our **Finance Officer** reported that the precept had been received and a donation to the Church for churchyard maintenance was agreed with an increase of 3.4%.

Inkberrow Environment Group were given permission to place an additional planter by the bench on Chestnut Close. The Parish Council thank the Environment Group for their contribution to enhancing our village and making it look so pretty and welcoming. The IEG were asked to maintain the grass around the planters because this wasn't in the current mowing contract

No Mow May was proposed and it was agreed that this had been done in some areas and the grass left longer in other areas to preserve grass in the dry weather.

Traffic congestion on Moreton Hall Lane was discussed and agreed it is a Highways issue. A number of locations for the 'Penguin Little Library Scheme' were suggested and the Clerk will contact the organiser to progress with this.

Tim Patrickson, Chair of the Millennium Green Trust, was delighted to take delivery of replacement picnic tables on the Millennium Green. These were kindly donated by Inkberrow WI and the Parish Council for the enjoyment of villagers and visitors to the Green. Allotment judging will take place on on June 18<sup>th</sup> 2025 at 6.45 pm

The overgrowing hedge and telecoms box on the A422 near the Flyfords.

The PC expressed their support to Neighbourhood Watch in progressing with Smart Water but require financial support from the Police and WCC in order to carry out the initiative at present.

Further research to be carried out on the Phone Box and if Inkberrow Men's Shed could possibly help with refurbishment.
