## Thought for the Month

From Rev<sup>'</sup>d Ian Perry, Priest in Charge of the Benefice of Inkberrow with Cookhill and Kington with Dormston



Nature is often described in Christian theology as a grand tapestry woven by the hands of the Creator, a living testimony of God's provision and care. From the delicate petals of a flower to the vast expanse of the starry heavens, nature is not merely a backdrop to human existence but a profound expression of God's love and providence.

Jesus Himself pointed to nature to illustrate God's faithful provision. In the Sermon on the Mount, He urged His followers to "consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these" (Matthew 6:28-29). The beauty of the natural world serves as a mirror reflecting God's character. The vastness of the heavens speaks to His immensity, the complexity of ecosystems reveals His wisdom, and the renewal of life in springtime echoes His promise of redemption. Rain and sunshine, essential elements for the growth of crops, demonstrate God's provision in a tangible way. The rhythms of nature — from the gentle rains that revive parched soil to the warmth of sunlight that nourishes life provide for human well-being and reflect God's tender care for His creation. We think of our farming community that are desperate for sustained rainfall after such a dry Spring.

Recognizing God's provision in nature cultivates a posture of gratitude. Each sunrise is a gift, each rainfall a reminder of His sustaining power. Gratitude also aligns the heart with God's purposes. It shifts the focus from human striving to divine sufficiency, fostering trust in God's ability to provide. In a world often marked by anxiety and scarcity, the abundant provision evident in nature serves as a stabilizing truth. The fields teem with crops under the nourishing sunlight, and the forests thrive after the life-giving rains, all pointing to a Creator who meets the needs of His creation.

While God's provision in nature is abundant, it comes with an implicit responsibility: stewardship. Humanity is called to care for the Earth as a sacred trust. Genesis 2:15 records that God placed Adam in the Garden of Eden "to work it and keep it," a mandate that extends to all of humanity. Nature's cycles of renewal and growth are also a testament to God's redemptive plan. Just as the Earth transforms barren winters into lush springs, so too does God bring life from death, beauty from ashes.

Reflecting on God's provision in nature can draw Christians into deeper relationship with their Creator, inspiring awe, gratitude, and a sense of purpose. Ultimately, nature is a divine gift, a living testimony of God's love and provision. It invites believers to pause, marvel, and worship the One who sustains all things. In every sunrise, every rainfall, and every blooming flower, the hand of the Creator is evident, calling humanity to acknowledge and cherish His bountiful grace. Please take a moment to pause and look up into the night sky and see the millions of stars, take a moment to gaze into fields and see the crops growing, take a moment to look at those we love and say thank you.

# Report from the Inkberrow Parish Council meeting on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> July

### **Highways matters**

The Parish Council have applied to Police and Crime Commissioners funding for an additional village VAS sign. This would be 'mobile' and moved between Withybed Lane and the Worcester Road at Holberrow Green. Let's keep our fingers crossed.

From July 21<sup>st</sup> for 4 days the Holberrow Green Road will be closed between Mile Post Lane and the A422 for Cadent supply to a new customer.

### Lengthsman activities

Various tasks to keep our village looking well kept and loved were discussed and the Lengthsman will be asked to strim areas around benches, maintain the allotment entrance and ensure our speed signs are visible. Thank you, Ian, for doing a wonderful job.

An Extraordinary meeting was held on June 17<sup>th</sup> to discuss and receive an update on the BES and Solar Farm Stock Green Planning Application. The meeting was well attended and was a good opportunity to revisit previous points made on the application and discuss further comments. The Parish Council will summarise the meeting and submit a formal objection to Wychavon.

Wychavon District Council have asked the Parish Council for some road name suggestions. There is a development of 4 houses and another development at Withyfields. The developers have put forward some suggestions to reflect the history of Inkberrow and local area. The Councillors had more suggestions of their own to reflect local history and figures; they are putting a number forward.

Notification for Prior Approval for the proposed change of use from commercial, business and service to Dwelling House. Cons End 23/06/2025. No objection.

The councillors attended the allotments prior to the meeting for the annual judging. This was brought forward by a month this year at the request of the allotment holders to reflect the abundance of fruit and veg in its prime. Winners will be announced at the Autumn Horticultural Show

Astwood Bank are having their Carnival on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> July so the main road will be closed for a period of time. Look out for notices.

A new Allotment Policy and changes proposed to future tenancy agreements were agreed.

The Parish Council were delighted to approve the purchase of a replacement tractor for the Play Area on Sands Road.

It was noted that the recycling bins at the Village Hall car park are to be removed. Wychavon are unable to find a contractor to empty the bins.

### Cookhill Village Hall – Update

Dance Floor – The committee have set up a fund to raise money for the replacement of the sprung dancefloor. They will look into quotes for this.

Shape Worcestershire: Local Government reorganisation - As you may be aware, the Government intends to sweep away all 21 two-tier council areas in England in favour of creating unitary councils. This represents the most significant change to how councils are structured, and services are delivered in the county in over 50 years. There are currently two options being considered for Worcestershire:

#### Replace all councils with one unitary council

This would replace the County Council and six District, City and Borough Councils with just one council for the whole of Worcestershire.

### Replace all councils with two unitary councils

This means the county would be split into two new councils with one for the north of the county and one for the south of the county.

Councillors will be asked in the autumn to decide which of the two options to work up in more detail and submit to the Government by 28 November 2025.

To support councillors to make this decision, Wychavon are seeking views from residents, alongside local
