

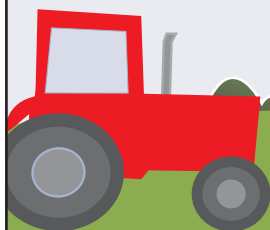

Thought for the Month

From Avril Rowlands



The seasons are rapidly changing, and autumn seems to be coming upon us very quickly, mainly due to the extreme lack of rain of the past months. Despite the glorious autumnal colours, it does begin to herald in winter, with short days and long nights. And that might be adding to a general mood of anxiety.

Many people have told me that they are unable to watch or read the news because everything is so depressing. And not just depressing. Frightening. Tensions rising between countries, wars, extreme famine, mass migration by those seeking a home and security, to say nothing of the worsening effects of climate change.

So, we might ask, where is God in all this? How does God allow, for example, the starvation in Gaza to continue? The war in Ukraine? You don't need me to write that the world seems to be in a more perilous place perhaps since the Cuban crisis of 1962 when the world came close to a nuclear war between the Soviet Union and the United States. We are fearful for ourselves, for our families, our friends, and I'm sure all parents and grandparents are anxious about the future for their children and grandchildren.

So where is God? A friend of mine recently said that while she could believe in an intelligent designer – in other words, God - who created the world, she thought that he then washed his hands of his creation and left us to get on with things – making often disastrous mistakes and muddling through as best we can.

As a Christian I know she is wrong. God doesn't wash his hands of us. No, he is there among us, working all the time to right what is wrong and bring us into a warm and loving relationship with him. He cares for us. In fact, he cares so much that he came himself, in the human form of Jesus, suffer for us on the cross, and by doing so to take our sins, all the mistakes, all the bad things we think and do in our lives, upon himself. Now that might sound very fine in the abstract, but how do we see God at work in our broken world today?

There are many, many ways.

We see God at work in the many selfless organisations dedicated to helping others both in this country and abroad.

We see God at work in the warmth and love of friends, relatives and neighbours. Jesus told us to love God and love your neighbour as yourself and we see God at work in our community – as I've had reason to experience following the death of my beloved husband, Chris.

We see God at work in the riches of the Bible, where God can speak to

us directly if we read and study the miracles of healing, the teaching and the life of our Lord. We find that Jesus understands our condition and offers us *'the peace that the world cannot give'*.

Jesus said: *'Come unto me all who are heavy laden and I will refresh you.'*

We see God at work in quiet moments if we listen to him and allow him to guide us in what we say and do.

And we see God at work all around us in nature and especially so as we are blessed to live in a place surrounded by beauty.

So as the seasons change and the leaves are turning brown and falling from the trees, let's take hope and courage from the fact that God is here, among us. Jesus said: *'Remember, I am with you always'*. God's love is constant, and God is with each one of us through all difficulties we face both internationally, nationally and individually. He is with us through all the seasons of our lives.

Summary of the meeting held on
Wednesday 20th August 2025

During the Open Public Question Time issues were raised on the speed of vehicles using Withybed Lane. The Parish Council agreed to support residents by reviewing the current signage and raising the issue with WCC Highways for advice. The construction activity and traffic at the Withyfield development is reported to be noisy, starting earlier than anticipated and damaging the road. There have also been reports that hedging has been removed without permission and a fence erected. The Parish Council are aware of all the issues and are in close contact with the site management team and the Planning Case Officer at Wychavon. Those residents in attendance were advised to raise matters with Wychavon Planning and/or Satvinder Bell, our local County Councillor.

Planning

Appeal was noted on W/25/01089 land at Holberrow Green. Closing Date Sept 2nd

No objection to W/25/01704/HP 1 Rock Hill Inkberrow Worcester WR7 4EZ Double storey side and rear extension.

WCC have a Rights of Way Improvement Plan (ROWIP). The Parish Council agreed to contact WCC and ask for a few posters to advertise this.

Finance

The Parish Council have received notification that they were not successful in their application for PCC funding for additional VAS .

The pay award of 3.2% had been approved.

Kington & Dormston Parish Council

Summary from the Parish Council Meeting held at the Village Hall on Monday 14th July 2025.

The Parish Council co-opted Jon Tuner onto Council following the resignation of Cllr Faizey who was thanked for her time and efforts.

Smart Water has now been agreed to be purchased by the Parish Council alongside a generous donation from Cllr Robinson. Neighbourhood Watch will be managing the roll out of Smart Water kits to all homes within the Parish. Please do engage with the initiative as not only will this help if any goods are stolen from your homes but the village needs a majority of kits to be registered in order to receive the signage which is a great deterrent for crime in the area.

The Parish council has been in touch with Inkberrow Men's Shed who hopefully will be working on refurbishing the blue telephone box upon entering the village in September. We realise that it looks unsightly however it is owned by the Police and we are liaising with them to fund the project or donate at least towards the costs.

A reminder that there are two defibrillators in the village should they ever be required- one at the Village Hall and another in the Churchyard at Kington. Councillors are researching a defibrillator training session and will be advertising details once confirmed.

Cllr Robinson shared that Reform UK has taken over the leadership of Worcestershire County Council. At the first full Council meeting Joanne Monk was sworn in as Council leader, and she went on to announce a new cabinet of Reform councillors. The new Cabinet member for Highways is Cllr. Carl Perks. The council has no overall majority, after Reform UK won 27 seats - two short of the 29 needed to secure control.

More of Cllr Robinson's report can be found in the full meeting minutes online or on the noticeboard.

The next meeting was agreed for Monday 8th September 2025 starting at 7:30pm in the Village Hall.

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Cookhill Village Hall – Update

Fete – The event was very well attended and everyone enjoyed a traditional style event. The committee would like it to become an annual event.
Harvest Supper – Proposed for 4th October – The Village Hall Committee will be meeting to discuss a Harvest Supper for October. *Further details to follow.*

Cookhill Playing Fields

A new outdoor Table Tennis table has been purchased by the Parish Council, using Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) funds, and will be installed at the Playing Fields over the next few weeks.

Cookhill Parish Council Website

The Parish Council website is 10 years old and needs an essential update. The recommendation is that parish council websites switch over to a .gov.uk domain and the councillors agreed to the necessary work being carried out. A new logo is also underway!

Cookhill Allotments Update

One plot available (35) with one person on the Waiting List who is waiting for a specific type of plot.

The annual Summer BBQ took place on the 2nd August. The weather was good and the event was well attended. Some tenants brought cakes and special potatoes grown on site.

Despite the dry weather most of the plots have had a good crop of vegetables and soft fruits. The fruit trees are also boasting a bumper crop of apples, pears and plums!

Quotes are being obtained for the essential repairs to the perimeter fence.

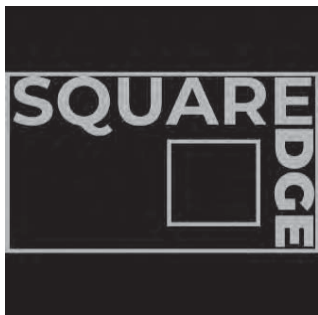

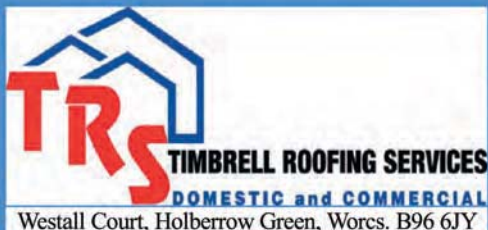
